## American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) E-Modules

In a contract with The Change Companies, AODS has purchased three ASAM E-Modules to support required training for Substance Use Disorder treatment providers. There are three e-modules, "Introduction to the ASAM Criteria", "Multidimensional Assessment" and "From Assessment to Service Planning". This online training function will assist treatment staff who are providing direct clinical services to beneficiaries in the Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System. As a reminder, staff who are conducting ASAM Criteria Placement Assessments and/or determining medical necessity as the LPHA for a treatment provider, must have ASAM training.

If a contract renewal is not submitted by the deadline, continued placements will not be guaranteed as of July 1, 2019 until the contract renewal has been executed.
