



Contra Costa Environmental Health has a NEW application and process for Mobile Food Facility (MFF) permit renewals.

- Permits expire December 31, 2022
- Complete and submit the following:
 - **Mobile Food Facility Permit to Operate Application**
 - **Payment** – in person, over the phone, by mail, or online:

- Once we receive all the requested documents and payment, an inspector will contact you to schedule an inspection

The current Environmental Health Permit fees are:

Unlimited Food Preparation Unit (PE 0718) \$896.00

Includes food preparation MFF with an extensive menu handling, preparing, and cooking potentially hazardous foods.

Limited Food Preparation Unit (PE 0708) \$728.00

Includes coffee carts, hotdog carts, corn roaster carts, tamale carts, shaved ice carts, handling non-prepackaged foods.

Pre-packaged Ice Cream Vehicle (PE 0728) \$454.00

Including pre-packaged ice cream, candy, chips, bottled beverages.

Pre-packaged Ice Cream Push Carts (PE 701-703) (price per cart)

1-4 carts (PE 701): **\$183.00** 5-10 carts (PE 702): **\$150.00** 11 or more (PE 703): **\$137.00**

Including pre-packaged ice cream, candy, chips, bottled beverages.

Pre-packaged Non-PHF Vehicle (PE 0738) > 25 sq. ft. \$454.00

Including dry foods, candies, chips, bottled beverages etc.

Whole Uncut Produce (PE 0740) > 25 sq. ft. \$199.00

Whole Produce only

Additional Units \$110.00

Mobile Support Unit (PE 0745): Separate unit that supplies such as food, potable water, dispose of liquid or solid wastes.

Auxiliary Conveyance Unit (PE 0746): Separate unit such as an approved sink (warewashing, food preparation, handwashing sink).

Additional Operating Unit (PE 0747): Additional operating unit such as a mechanical refrigeration unit or additional storage unit.
