

Your Opportunity to Learn What Local Companies Are Doing to Prevent Accidents

The California Accidental Release Prevention (CalARP) Program, Contra Costa County's Industrial Safety Ordinance (ISO), and the City of Richmond's Industrial Safety Ordinance (RISO) require companies with regulated chemicals to submit a Risk Management Plan (RMP) and Safety Plan (SP). Plans include:

- A description of the hazardous materials present,
- The accident prevention programs in place,
- The facility's emergency response program, and
- The management systems in place to implement the overall program.

The CalARP Program requires the Contra Costa Health Services Hazardous Materials Programs (CCHSHMP) to perform document reviews and audits to ensure companies are complying with the CalARP/ISO/RISO regulations and are following the programs listed in their RMPs and SPs. A forty-five days public comment period for the Preliminary Audit Findings and RMPs listed below begins on **October 28, 2020** and will end on **December 11, 2020**. Public access to these and other CalARP/ISO documents for regulated facilities have been available at the CCHSHMP Office in Martinez or at the libraries listed below. However, with limited public access due to the Covid-19 pandemic; CCHSHMP is providing these documents on the facility description page access from our general website: <https://cchealth.org/hazmat/rmp/>. Binders containing hard copies are also available for review at the libraries when they are re-opened to the public.
